# The Path – Navigation Guide

The Path 2023 consists of six modules as follows:

Module 1: Name Calling

**Module 2: Land and Stories** 

Module 3: Canada's Colonial History

**Module 4: Contemporary Realities** 

Module 5: Relationship Building

**Module 6: Towards Truth and Reconciliation** 

Each module is divided into lessons filled with multimedia learning objects and resources. Some modules are longer than others with Module 3 being the longest.

There are Knowledge Assessments at the end of each module. On completion, this grade is automatically transferred to a participant's personal profile (Grades) on the Learning Management System (LMS).

What appears on your screen may vary over time from the screenshots below as both the interface and Learning Management System versions are updated periodically. Navigation will remain much the same. This Guide will be updated when any significant changes take place.

After creating an account on <u>https://nvisionthepath.ca/</u>, locating your version of The Path from the search bar or alphabetical list, and entering the assigned enrolment key, the course opens as shown below.



After completing **Welcome – Start Here**, tabs for all the modules will show. The **Survey**, **Certificate** tab will appear once at least five modules have been successfully completed, but the Certificate will not be available until all six modules have been successfully completed.

After clicking on Welcome – Start Here, the following screen appears.

The **Exit activity** button may be hidden if your screen is zoomed in. Scroll up a bit to see the button.



Modules may open with a black screen displaying a play button. Click the play button to begin.



Exit activity and logout at any point.



Return to the page last accessed by choosing to **Resume**.

Some pages have hyperlinks to hidden pages. In this case the first link changed colour (green), indicating it has been visited.



Play the hidden page. When the narration ends, it will close, and the lead page will appear again. Some pages require all items to be selected. On others, the NEXT button is visible and active.

PREV and NEXT on a hidden page will navigate to menu pages. The PREV button below will not go to the page above, but the page before this one.



Each module ends with a Knowledge Assessment.



It is recommended that Knowledge Assessments be completed in one sitting to ensure the grade is properly recorded. Questions are numbered.
